



Title of Project: **Supply and installation of Solar Street Lights and supply and delivery of Handheld Solar Lanterns at Nduta Refugee Camp, Kibondo, Tanzania**

Project Overview:

Nduta refugee camp opened on 4 October 2015, as an emergency measure to relocate 40,000 Burundian refugees from Nyarugusu refugee camp (decongestion). New arriving Burundian refugees were hosted in Mtendeli refugee camp once Nduta reached its initial maximum capacity of 50,000 persons (January 2016). Since Mtendeli refugee camp reached its capacity of 50,000 on 3rd October 2016, the government agreed to reopen Nduta refugee camp again to host all newly arriving Burundians. Population in 2018 105.000.

In order to increase security specifically in the women's section of the camp CAA was contracted for the supply and installation of 136 solar powered streetlights. Additionally CAA supplied 2.120 Multi solar lantern Mosquito killer to be distributed to the inhabitants.
